## Nindooinbah shows off females

CATTLE breeding centre Nindooinbah threw open its doors recently to introduce agents and clients to the operation's impressive facilities near Beaudesert.

The day began with lunch, followed by presentations from Nindooinbah owner Euan Murdoch, manager Nick Cameron, breeding consultant Don Nicol and Angus Australia CEO Peter Parnell.

The 100 guests then enjoyed a tour of the operation, which took in the purpose-built implant and embryo transfer centre and the stud Angus and Ultrablack females that will be offered for sale at Nindooinbah tomorrow, March 23.

Tomorrow's sale will mark the first Ultrablack stud female in Australia. The base for the Ultrablacks is a herd of 600-plus of the top performance-recorded Angus females in the

country mated or flushed to semen from trait leading US Brangus sires. Ultrablacks have 3/16 Brahman and 13/16 Angus content. Interest from northern buyers is expected to be strong and the sale will be conducted by Elders and interfaced with Auctions Plus. The sale will offer 121 Angus cows and 180 Ultrablack heifers.
